Almshouse, Kent County government, School District 18 (Dover), Methodist
Church in Camden, Dr. Henry Ridgely, George P. Fisher, James Allee, A.
B. Richardson, Nathanel P. Smithers, and various ships. One document
inside the volume indicates they were shipping corn from Port Mahon to
Boston.
