261 Record of Frear's farm and personal accounts. He owned several farms in Kent County, living on one near Rising Sun. His son, J. Allen Frear, Jr., was a U. S. Senator from 1949-1961.
270 These books show his farm and personal expenditures, income received, hired hand accounts, property rental accounts, and farm production records. Some of the entries are personal records such as the date his father came to live with him, when he bought property, and funds collected for Fred Grey after his farm burned in 1925,

Also included is a small School District 27 and 122 tax collector's book, a copy of a 1921 school budget law, and a published table, "State School Budget For Each of the School Years 1921-22 and 1922-23." The tax collector's book (1913-1918) for the Rising Sun and Lebanon area notes the tax year, name of taxpayer, and amount of taxes paid for each district.
