261 The Association was a cooperative marketing organization of more than 22,000 farmers in Delaware, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and Maryland supplying dairy products to Philadelphia. Most of these records are from the Wilmington Marketing Committee and include organizational records, lists of producers, Association history, and correspondence.  
270 Correspondence includes letters to the editor, letters to members, and letters to dairies. Subjects include milk pricing during the Depression, conflict with the Allied Dairy Farmers' Association, oleomargarine, purity standards, pricing, payments to farmers, discrimination against Holstein milk, and milk transportation. Also present is a draft copy of the by-laws, a detailed history of the Association, two lists of milk producers in the Wilmington area, and a few meeting notices and agendas.
