Also present are cantaloupe crate labels from Minner's son, Amos, and pension application records for Washington Bennett (1877-1890). Included in the box are two textbooks from the Masten's Corner District 58 School: *A First Book in American History with European Beginnings* (1919) and *Essentials of Arithmetic* (1915).
