261 Primarily a collection of receipts from the Pennewill family of Kent
County.
270 The bulk of this collection is receipts, some with itemized expenses,
for goods, services and unspecified transactions. Land records
featuring sketches, correspondence, deeds and maps, are also included.
Notably found in this collection are plans for a road from Dover to
Little Creek, which bisects R. O. Pennewill's land (no date). Also
included are court documents discussing debts owed by John Hunn
(deceased) to Caleb Pennewill (1864). Furthermore, correspondence
between Warner & Co. and J. C. Pennewill discussing produce orders
mentions issues at John Hunn's farm. Insurance policies in John C.
Pennewill's name found among these records describe feature of his farm
protected under each policy. Finally, a notebook, family history and a
family tree are included.
