early to late twentieth century. The towns with the most cards are
Georgetown, Rehoboth, and Wilmington. Other towns with a number of cards
are Dover, Laurel, Milford, Newark, Seaford, and Delaware City. Many
popular images in this collection depict aerial views, beaches,
businesses, state buildings, libraries, post offices, private
residences, hospitals, restaurants, landmarks, parks, banks, churches,
schools, colleges, railroads, armories, hotels, street scenes, fairs,
monuments, Fort DuPont, and many types of waterways. Many of the
postcards display photographic, illustrative, or printed pictorials of
Delaware. These postcards have either been unused or mailed, showing
correspondence, stamps, and addresses. This collection also includes a
few postcards depicting waterways and railroad stations from Maryland.
