 261 Lewis B. Chandler was a Milton businessman who dealt in drugs, medicines, paint, oil, glass, and dry goods, was involved in growing fruits and vegetables, and was also a building contractor. He also had a partnership with John F. Fisher of Milton to pack fruits and vegetables and ship the products. These records reflect his business and personal interests.
 270 Many of the papers are agreements and leases. Chandler was either a participant or a witness to these legal documents. The records include an agreement for a Georgetown hotel with Peter J. Hart, a hotel in Milton, with John F. Fisher and the Councilman Canning Company, and agreements with Joseph L. Blook and Walter L. Fulmer, James P. Jones and Benjamin B. Jones and William A. Hazzard and Thomas Marshall. Other papers include business-related receipts and bills.

Also present is a journal used to track his financial interests. The volume was also used as a scrapbook with newspaper clippings on medical remedies and growing various types of fruits and vegetables. Other records include his Farmer's Bank deposit record book, 1872-1879, his appointment certificate as Governor James Ponder's Aide-de-Camp, 1871, and a copy of David E. Wolf's will, 1885.
