 261 Scrapbooks containing news clippings and program pamphlets depicting highlights of Mr. T. Leslie Carpenter's career as a concert organist, teacher of piano, organ, singing, and theory, composer of music for church services, and organist and choirmaster for Wilmington's Trinity Episcopal Church.
 270 The collection consists of three scrapbooks and two binders. The three scrapbooks contain a carefully organized series of newspaper clippings and performance programs which document the long career of Carpenter. The newspaper clippings contain articles that range from the various paid advertisements he ran for student enrollment into his school of music, and programs of performances of his students, to articles depicting debuts of his written pieces on piano, his performances on organ, church services which featured the church choir he directed, exclusive political gatherings which requested his presence given his considerable reputation in music, and in 1947, his own personal obituary.

The two binders consist of a typed "Record of Musical Societies in Wilmington, 1800-1940" and several letters about the project. Carpenter was the chairman of the committee that compiled this history of musical societies in Wilmington. The histories of seventy-seven musical societies, bands, concert groups, clubs, military bands, choruses, quartettes, orchestras, theaters, festivals, and associations are chronicled.

In some of the scrapbooks, the pages have begun to separate from the binding. For the two binders, the outer covers and the pages inside are in good condition. Though in both binders, the metal rings have begun to

rust.
