261 Primarily correspondence of the Cochran family of Cochran Grange, Middletown. Most are to/from John P. Cochran, who was Governor from 1875-1879, and his son John. His granddaughter Mary who married Howard Pool, was the donor of the collection.
270 The correspondence consists of letters by John P. Cochran to his son and from family members on the death of his son. John Jr.'s letters also include poetry sent to his wife Ella Pennington. Some of the correspondence was written to John, Jr., when he was president of the Philomathean Literary Society of Pennsylvania.

Other records include a deed between Cornelia L. Munn and others to Mary Cochran Pool for a piece of land located in Rehoboth Beach. Also included are several school reports for John Cochran, materials relating to the USS Olympia, newspaper clippings about events at the Forest Presbyterian Church, a clipping about the White House receiving a mirror from the Rehoboth Art League, and two Middletown postcards.
