 261 Papers and official forms as collected and maintained by Captain George W. Chaytor of Wilmington, Delaware during his course of service in the Mexican War. Captain Chaytor, also a physician, assisted in raising a unit from Delaware to serve in the U.S. Army for the Mexican War campaign. Although Captain Chaytor was able to accompany this unit to Mexico on a steamship, he immediately became ill after landing in Mexico and was sent back home where he continued to maintain his rank and responsibilities although away from his unit through to the end of the war.

430 The personal papers and materials of Capt. Chaytor were placed under another series (RG 9200.C18.001). The military papers herein described had been placed originally under RG 1800.000.023 and have been subsequently removed and placed in the Small Manuscript Collection due to they may have been deposited in the Archives at the same time as the personal papers and materials. No accession reference has been located to date for either the personal or military papers. A rough checklist of some of this material was created by State Archivist, George H. Ryden, who served in the position during the 1930's. This Chaytor material may have been donated during his term here in the Archives. Chaytor descendants lived in the Wilmington area through most of the early twentieth century.
