261 Photographs relating to Wilmington's trolley and bus system. They were collected by John Collins, a career-long employee of the Wilmington transit companies, Delaware Electric Power Company, Delaware Coach Company, Greater Wilmington Transit Authority, and Delaware Authority for Regional Transit (DART).
270 The photograph subjects include horse-drawn trolleys, electric trolleys, trackless trolleys, buses, trolley and bus barns, and the company office building. Also present are early 1900s car inventory sheets which have a photo of the trolley and a typed description of the body and truck dimensions, type of truck and wheel, seating capacity, the car number, manufacturer's name, type of electrical equipment, weight of the components, and total weight of the car. The trolleys were built by Lamokin, J. G. Brill, Jackson and Sharp, Norristown, John Stephenson, and American Car and Foundry. In addition, there are several builder's photos of trolleys from the J. G. Brill Company.
