Thomas Cooper served in the Delaware State Legislature as both a member
of the House of Representatives and the Senate (1803-1811) and also as
a member of the U.S. House of Representatives (1813-1817). Thomas was
the son of Isaac Cooper, a former State legislator and a Sussex County
delegate to State Convention to ratify the new Federal proposed
constitution in 1787 and the State Constitutional Convention in 1792.
Thomas's brother, William B. Cooper, was Governor of Delaware (1841-
1845).
