deeds, apprentice indentures, wills, leases, invoices and receipts, and
insurance policies. Other items include a copy of the *Calendar of John
Dickinson Family Papers* by Dr. John Powell, background material on
Croisiadore (Talbot County, Maryland birthplace of John Dickinson), and
copies of family silhouettes. Also of note is a large printed 1782
proclamation by Pennsylvania President John Dickinson and a printed
copy of the 1802 State of the State Address that President Thomas
Jefferson sent to Dickinson.

Most of these records are copies from the Historical Society of
Pennsylvania and the Delaware Historical Society. There are four boxes
of original documents.
