261 Minute book containing the minutes for the annual meetings of the Horse Pen Drain Ditch Company. The company was incorporated in 1841. The ditch company's marshes were situated in Murderkill Hundred, near the Horse Pen Drain Branch of the Murderkill River in Kent County.  
270 A minute book for the Horse Pen Drain Ditch Company from 1897-1931. The book contains transcriptions of the legislation that created the company from 1841, 1869, 1897, as well as minutes from meetings held by marsh owners and Board of Directors. Most meetings were held annually in April. The minutes list members present by name, meeting organizer, and meeting secretary. Meetings mostly addressed the maintenance of the ditches. Minutes list the owners of land in the ditch company, as well as the number of acres of marsh that they held, the assessed price on the land, and the amount of taxes owed. In some cases, surveys and descriptions of the land are included.
