270 John Gilbride Davis was the son of Frank Hall Davis Sr. and Vera Davis. He served in World War II and was in Europe for the Battle of Metz. Many records found in this series are on the history of Metz and the battle at Metz. There are also scrapbook pages from John's visit in 1995 to Metz for the 50th anniversary of the liberation of Metz. Other records include: his childhood account book, application for a Delaware Commission of Veteran Affairs certificate of appreciation, application for the Medal of Metz, appointment to Deputy Sheriff records, certificate awarding him a Bronze Star Medal & Combat Infantry badge, his birth certificate, Selective Service Bulletin of Information for persons registered in war, Camp Appoquinimink brochures, Georgetown Prep School application for admission, Georgetown Prep School report card & diploma, Georgetown Prep The Blue and Gray student publication, honorable discharge papers, recommendation letters for transfer to another branch of the Army, letter from Franklin Delano Roosevelt to members of the U.S. Army, maps of Europe and Metz, and a rejection letter from the Naval Academy. *The Legacy of the 95th Infantry Division in World War II* book and a World War II scrapbook that John Davis put together with newspaper clippings from 1939 can also be found in this series.
