Records in this series include certificate appointing her a member of the Commission for Aid to Dependent Children, family correspondence, certificate stating she's the first Delawarean honored by the Delaware Society for Crippled Children and Adults with the lifetime rank of President Emeritus, dance cards from local dinner dances, Delaware Women's Hall of Fame induction program, a 1943 Equal Rights amendment with Vera's notes, Holy Cross cemetery grave plot purchase receipt, bonds and deeds, letter to Vera requesting her to run for re-election for State Treasurer, newspaper clippings, 1950 Republican Primary Election Official Ballot with results, Senate Calendar for the 115th General Assembly, State Board of Welfare financial statement, State Treasurer certificate of election, tax return, program for the play "The Pennant" directed by Vera Davis, Vera's mass of Christian burial remembrance card, and a war ration book.
