He attended West Point, became a Brigadier General in the Corps of Engineers, and served in World War I. During his career and especially after his retirement in 1931, he conducted family history research. He passed away in 1945.  
270 The correspondence, mostly with family members, relates to family news and genealogy. The family history is a 106 page typed transcript with genealogical and personal information. In addition to the Deakyne family, other related families include the Liston, David, Derrickson, and Staats.
