270 The 1945-1947 scrapbook has Farmers Bank publications including a Buy War Bonds brochure, advertisements for Bank services, president's report to stockholders, Farmers Bank war record, "How to Prepare Your Personal Income Tax Return," press releases, Christmas cards, and a first aid index. Other publications present are *The Business of Farming* and *Popular Home* magazines. Newspaper clippings relate to the final war bond drive, World War II Honor Roll, Dover's Victory Clothing Committee for Overseas Relief, military veterans, weddings, Fisk Jubilee Singers, Dover USO Club, bank employees and their family members, obituaries, new coins, a bank embezzlement, and ads for bank services.

The ca. 1952-1953 scrapbook is primarily Farmers Bank advertisements placed in local newspapers. It includes publications sponsored by the bank such as "How to Do Your Banking", "How a Stockholder Can Help His Bank," "Farming for Profit," "Your Soil Conservation District," and "Who are your heirs if you make no will?"
