Councilwoman, 1947-1949. She was also the wife of U. S. Senator J.
Allen Frear.
270 Records consist of minutes, city charter (1936), financial statements
(1942-1948), ordinances, reports, correspondence, Dover publications,
lists of local organization officers, newspaper clippings, and
statistical information on Dover. Many of the records deal with the
failure of the city to generate sufficient power for the local
businesses, especially International Latex Corporation. Of interest are
the minutes of a meeting of the Aviation Committee to discuss whether
the city would take over management of the Dover Army Air Field, 1947.
Other records include an invitation to the dedication of the Governor
Bacon Health Center, 1948; a report on the electrical requirements in
Milford, 1948; the program and invitation for the volunteer firemen's
commemorative stamp first sale event, 1948; and activities reports from
the YMCA, 1947. Publications include informational booklets on Dover,
1929 (photocopy), 1940s, 1950s, and 1973; *Dover: The First Two Hundred
and Fifty Years, 1717-1967*; and the "Town Crier", 1979.
