261 Ledgers and a journal, most relating to Fisher's activities as a property manager, fruit and grain broker, and administrator for estates going through probate.
270 The first volume, 1875-1889, is primarily a property management ledger. It notes money received for house rents, local taxes and insurance paid, property repairs, mortgage payments, Fisher's commission, and other expenditures. In the back of the book are ledger entries for railroad cars of unidentified produce that were shipped.

The 1910-1920 ledger contains his administrator accounts to settle the estates of two persons who had died, W. P. Lindale and Mary A. Gruett. There are also accounts for his service as trustee to the Lindale heirs. In the back of the book are a few entries for farm tenants and the crops they produced, 1919, 1921.

A 1922-1927 ledger records amounts of grass and cherries that were sold to commission merchants. No financial amounts were entered. A shipping journal for 1925 records the date, name of the shipper, names of consignors, and amount of grass that was sent from Wyoming to George Allison & Company in New York City.
