270 The research files in the collection document the Frame ancestry from the 17<sup>th</sup> to the 20<sup>th</sup> century. There are records of the first Frame males who settled in Sussex County. The majority of the records are vital records such as marriage, birth, and death records, along with baptisms, gravestone photos, probates, pensions, military, and land records. Some of the land records contain plots, inventory lists, and deeds. There are some files that deal with individual Frame family members, while other files have either miscellaneous Frame family members, land records from Sussex County, tombstones, or Orphans' Court records. There are also a few records having to do with the Blizzard, Burton, Paynter, Springfield, Waples, and Warrington families. A diary excerpt from Hannah Burton is also present in the files, along with short histories of the 26<sup>th</sup> governor of Delaware, Samuel Paynter, and the 45<sup>th</sup> governor of Delaware, Charles C. Stockley.

In the first folder of the collection, there is biography of Esther Friend.
