270 The letters to Gillett and Company are from the Capelle & Brother Company, located at 212 Market and 219 King Streets in Wilmington, and in 1882, a different company, J. V. Carlisle & Company, located at 303 Market and 302 Shipley Streets. Both companies were dealers in hardware that purchased ship augers with and without screws and auger bits to sell to local customers. The letters include orders with the size and kind of augers and payments and complaints concerning defective augers. Also included are two pages from New York directories with the Gillett & Company listed and an advertisement for a new product, an asbestos pad for sad irons.
