261 Daybook belonging to Manlove Hayes serves as a record of accounts and business transactions of various individuals living in Kent County.
270 The Daybook is divided into two parts based on a lapse in chronology. The first part is denoted as the "Hayes & Comegys Day Book Commenced at Dover in 1809 and ending in Oct. 1811." Detailed merchandise lists note the purchase of "sundries" such as household goods, cloth, boots, and animal feed. Lists are organized chronologically according to date of purchase; notes detailing who the item was purchased for are also included, if applicable. The following pages list each person and a chronological statement of their account including debts, disbursements, purchases, and transactions. Of note are account records for York Seat Farm and Little Creek Landing Farm. Repeated account records exist for Anthony Blackiston, Jacob Dodd, Gouverneur Emerson, Elisha Harris, James Luff, Levin Pennewill, and Henry Rodney. Towards the back of the Daybook are miscellaneous notes: two about bound servants indentured to CP Hayes and Manlove Hayes Jr., respectively; one about an account with Farmer's Bank; and one about "Notes and Bonds Due."
