270 Many of the prints and engravings contained in this series depict European buildings, landscapes, and scenes; some print information is written in French. It is possible these were collected by Gouverneur Emerson while traveling in France during the early nineteenth century. Items of note include one reprinted cartoon attributed to William Hogarth; two prints of buildings in Nimes, France; and a sketch drawn by hand, possibly in charcoal. Also included in this series is a set of thirteen portraits published exclusively for the *European Magazine*. Other portraits in this series are identified only by first name while others are unidentified. One portrait of note is of a young female and is titled "Rosa"; this could be the author Rosa Johnson, whose poetry was collected by Gouverneur Emerson. Non-European items of note in this series include a print of a Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania, residence and a pictorial review of Abraham Lincoln by Carl Sandburg.
