270 The majority of the records are receipts reflecting the payment of personal bills and taxes. Other records include an apprentice release for Mary E. Allston (negro, 1867), correspondence concerning the location of General Braddock's sword (1932), advertisement for the Dyer & Casson dry goods store in Dover, the poem "The German Sneer," 1918, deeds for John C. Hargadine's property (1860, 1866), seven photographs, a recipe for medicinal syrup, a deed for Richard Sitler's property in Philadelphia (1848), and a receipt signed by James Sykes (1814). In addition to the Hargadine family, there are receipts for Isaac Callahan; Ann, Emily, John, and Rachael Craig; and B. and Josiah Wallace.
