261 Primarily correspondence written to Henry C. Robinson and Wilmington mayor Austin Harrington from Delaware businesses and individuals regarding donations of money and goods to the victims of the 1889 flood in Johnstown, Pennsylvania.  
270 These letters reference check numbers, donation amounts ranging from \$2 to \$1000 and information about how these fund were raised by the various groups and organizations that made the donations. Additionally, a number of letters include subscription lists noting individual contributions within larger donations. These letters also contain brief descriptions of supplies sent to Johnstown. Notable business and individual donors include The Seidel and Hastings Co, Wilmington; The Jessup & Moore Paper Co, Rockland; Philadelphia, Wilmington & Baltimore Railroad Company, Wilmington; The National Bank of Newark; Wm. Du Pont, Wilmington; Hilles & Jones, Wilmington; Marshall Iron Company, Newport; Betts Machine Co, Wilmington; C & J Pyle Company, Wilmington; Hawkins & Co, Wilmington; Jackson and Sharp, Wilmington; and Diamond State Iron Company, Wilmington. Also included in this collection is a letter of receipt of donations in the amount of \$500 from the chief engineer of the Cambria Iron Company, Johnstown, PA, to Mayor Harrington.
