businessman, Executive Vice President and Treasurer of the Delaware  
Bankers Association, and local historian.  
270 Files include information on the Delaware Bankers Association, his work  
on the campaigns of Governor Charles Terry (1968) and Senator Allen  
Frear (1954, 1960), Jackson family history, a copy of the 1929 Dover  
High School "Pilot" for which Jackson provided the artwork, and his  
service on the Governor's Finance Committee (1965), Dover Charter Review  
Committee (1986), and the Dover Bicentennial Committee (1974). One  
folder contains correspondence, ballots, a proclamation, and a copy of  
an act from the career of Jackson's father, Charles T. Jackson, who  
served as a state representative, 1932-1935. There is also an invoice  
from the James B. Bice hardware store in Dover, 1913. Also contained in  
this series are photographs of Jackson, the Dover Honor Roll, and  
Moore's Mill.
