 personal interests. Davis (1823-1898) lived in the Milford area.  
 270 Entries show name of each account, date of transaction, what goods or  
 services being sold, amount due, date of payment, how paid, and amount  
 paid. The front of the book has notations on when cattle breeding  
 occurred. The back of the book has entries for financial notes due to  
 Davis, reminders of when crops were sowed and harvested, notes on  
 contracts and laborers, crop yield statistics, an orchard layout, his  
 tax assessment, and personal expenses and income. Separate documents  
 that had been placed in the book include receipts for house furnishings,  
 slate of candidates for the Union ticket (1865), and a List of the  
 Taxables in United School District Nos. 5 & 116 (1861-1862). This list  
 shows the names of the taxables, amount of personal and real property,  
 total, and amount of tax.
