261 Primarily a record of license fees collected by Dorsey, who was Kent County Clerk of the Peace from 1862 to 1867. His personal accounts are also included.  
270 Dorsey issued marriage, retailer, peddler, liquor, tavern, and stallion licenses. Other fees were collected for constables commissions, certifications, and copies. Entries show the type of license sold, date sold, who sold to, amount of clerk fee, and amount of state fee. The 1862-1863 entries for marriage licenses show the names of the groom and bride; entries for 1863 to 1868 give the groom's name only. Some of the lists of retailer licenses issued includes the town of the retailer. At the back of the book are Statements of Fees Received (1864-1867) which list how many licenses were sold for each type of license and how much money was collected for each.

Dorsey's accounts with C. C. Rhoads of Philadelphia, 1868-1869, are mostly payments for the purchase of supplies and to workmen for ditch construction and lumbering. They show date, name of person, work performed or supplies purchased, and amount.
