261 The Papers consist of articles, correspondence, work history, newspaper clippings, and Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) records compiled by E. Elwood Lynch (1908-2002). Lynch started his career with the CCC in 1933 and joined the Delaware Mosquito Control Commission in 1935. In 1940 its functions were transferred to the State Highway Department. He remained with the Department as a Mosquito Control Engineer until 1949 when he was terminated due to a change in political party control. He came back to State service for 1953-1956 and then joined the Maryland Mosquito Control.

270 Most of the articles (1941-1950) were co-written by Lynch. These include "Mosquito-Control Developments in Delaware During 1940," "Mosquito-Control Developments in Delaware During 1941," "Report of the Use of DDT and Paris Green on Muskrat Marshes," "Resort Protection by Restricting the Migration of Aedes Mosquitoes," "The Use of Aircraft in the Control of Mosquitoes," "Salt Marsh Mosquito Control By Airplane Spraying in Delaware," and "Influence of a Low Forest-Canopy on the Effectiveness of Plane Application of DDT Against Mosquito Larvae."

The CCC records (1935-2000) consist of Lynch's Certificate of Discharge, correspondence about the sod monument and a reunion, and newspaper clippings. The work history records include correspondence about his past work experience, letters of recommendations, letters of termination, and newspaper clippings. Also present is a letter of recommendation signed by Senators Daniel O. Hastings and John G. Townsend, Jr. Also of interest is a mosquito cartoon from 1942 and a family history chart provided by the donor.
