261 This folder contains selected entries copied from the diary of Archibald Moor who served aboard military vessels during the Civil War.
270 Archibald Moor describes life in the Navy including service on the USS State of Georgia, USS Brooklyn, and USS North Carolina. He describes conditions aboard the ships, daily drills, ports of call, meals, and the apparent suicide of a member of the crew. Moor mentions being at the 1st battle of Bull Run, Fort Meyers, Fort Powell, Fort Fisher, and Fort Gains. This diary contains a description of a battle with the confederate ironclad RAM, CSS Tennessee and the battle to take Fort Morgan and Mobile, AL (1865). Moore also briefly mentions a number of other vessels in his diary as they gathered the fleet together in December 1864.
