270 The thirteen deeds date from 1791-1884 and include Urania Burr to George Marshall, 1884; Edward Smith to Aaron Marshall, 1828; and Rehoboth Beach Camp Meeting Association to John W. Causey, 1877. Additional items include general merchant James Tharp's Account Book for 1817-1830; probate records for Nathan Davis, 1821; a Kent County Orphans' Court property valuation, 1828; a Rhoads Shankland survey for land north of Georgetown, 1764; a statement about Solomon Kimmey's skull at Waitman Booth's house, n.d.; will of Beniah Watson, 1844; an appointment of John Causey as special agent of the General Land Office, 1896; a commission for William Marshall as a Major in the Delaware National Guards, 1913; medical school diplomas for George Marshall and Samuel E. Marshall, 1847, 1882; "100 Years of Memories, Beta Epsilon Chapter, Kappa Alpha Order, University of Delaware, 1904-2004;" "Milford Emergency Hospital," 1917; and a yearbook for the Sons of Delaware, 1898.

Other records document transactions involving governors William Tharp, Peter Causey and William Watson. There are probate records for William Tharp, 1866; a William Tharp political testimonial, ca. 1847; and correspondence from Secretary of State Daniel Moore Bates to Governor William Tharp relating to a petition and appointment, 1848; a deed from Peter Causey to John W. Causey, 1871; and two deeds between William Watson and Ruth Carlisle, 1875, 1879. Additional records present are a biography of Sydenham Thorne, a booklet for the one hundredth anniversary of the First Presbyterian Sunday School, 1947, and publications relating to the Milford Memorial Hospital.
