261 Accounts, agreements, correspondence, deeds, inventories, plots, and other records from the Moore family of Broad Creek and Little Creek Hundreds, Sussex County.
270 Accounts (1800-1886) consist of receipts for services rendered or products purchased, receipts for the payment of taxes, bills, and lists of goods purchased. Also included are administration accounts for the estates of Sarah Moore (1827-1829), Samuel Ralph (1869-1871), George W. Kimmey (1874-1876), and guardian accounts for Albert and Sarah Ralph (1870-1879). Agreements (1808-1823) relate to sharecropper contracts, property rental, and the use of slaves. Correspondence (1797-1891) is a mixture of personal and business exchanges. Deeds (1799-1933) are the most numerous type of document in the collection. Most were recorded in the Recorder of Deeds Office. Inventories or sale lists exist for the estates of Emmanuel Walker (1814), Mathias D. Bailey (1828), George W. Kinney (1875), and William S. White (1908). There are three small plots for land of George Moore (no date), Thomas Rider and others (no date), and Levin Moore to John Moore (1817). Other records of note include a sale of property from Charles Hutton to Jane Nicholson, including a slave, in 1811; a record of Mary Moore's death date and the division of slaves to her children, ca. 1817; and a copy of the will of Charles N. Moore, 1890.
