261 Correspondence, membership cards, and receipts from the Washington Camp Number 10, Patriotic Order Sons of America, a patriotic and nativist national organization in Magnolia. The Patriotic Order provided unemployment insurance and death benefits for its members.
270 The correspondence (1908-1911, 1923) was from local doctors verifying a member's illness, from the Funeral Benefit Association listing members who had died and the benefits awarded, from the National Camp providing information on the Diamond Jubilee celebration in Philadelphia, and from the State Camp with tickets and an advertisement for a fund-raiser at the Dover Opera House. The membership cards (1923-1924) show the date, name of applicant, place of birth, age, occupation, address, and name of the member proposing membership. The receipts (1911) are for membership dues and the purchase of record books.
