261 Primarily farm financial records maintained by Mrs. Pinder. The Pinders raised poultry, livestock, and produce on their farm west of Townsend. Farm income was derived from the sale of milk, eggs, corn, barley, potatoes, cattle, poultry, trees, and government payments.
270 The records consist of Farm Account Books, 1947-1963, 16 booklets, and Egg and Feed Records, ca. 1950-1957, 4 booklets. The 1947-1950 Account Books show the date, item purchased or sold, amount received or paid, and monthly totals. Items are categorized by cash, farm, equipment, truck or tractor, labor, cattle, hogs, poultry, corn, potatoes, orchard, and auto. The 1951-1963 books have a cash income section showing income from the sale of cattle, poultry, dairy products, eggs, grain, other crops, and other sources. The cash expense section shows hired labor expenses, feed purchased, seeds and plants, machine hire, supplies, repairs and maintenance, fertilizers, fuel and oil, taxes, insurance, utilities, freight, auto upkeep, and hatching and blood testing poultry. There are also pages for purchases of livestock and capital items, and a depreciation section. Also included within the volumes are animal testing reports, receipts, and informational notices.

The Egg and Feed Records are monthly statistics showing the number of eggs gathered each day, number of hens, how many birds died or culled, and amount of feed used. Also included in this series is the "Farmer's 1951 Income Tax" and the "Farmer's 1953 Income Tax" bulletin published by the University of Delaware Agricultural Extension Service.
