270 The records include: The Certificate of Incorporation, Minutes of the Meetings of the Board of Directors, 1934-1945; a scrapbook with entries from 1929 to 1959; correspondence about the school to and from hospitals, colleges, the General Assembly, and legal advisers; also a reference collection of books on the education of the deaf, and Annual Reports of the Home for Training in Speech, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, 1894-1922. It was in this school that Margaret Sterck trained and taught from 1909 to 1929. She was trained in the Garrett Oral method for teaching the deaf.
The scrapbook includes original correspondence, photographs, news clippings and other notes.
