the American Revolution is a national organization of direct
decedents of patriots of the American Revolution. The Delaware
Society of Sons of the American Revolution, founded in 1890, is
among the country's oldest.

The applications in this collection, organized numerically in
order of acceptance, detail the lineage of the candidates.
Genealogical evidence provided on these forms includes vital
statistics of the applicant and ancestors relevant to attaining
membership. Most applications include a statement of service for
the qualifying ancestor, describing his contribution to achieving
American independence during the Revolution. Information about
applicant's spouses and decedents is often included along with
military service, geographic location and references.

These applications are of deceased members of the organization.
Place holders for applications of living members have been
interfiled among the applications.
