Wilson (1883-1971) was executive secretary of the Delaware Parent-Teacher Association, an organization that worked with the Service Citizens of Delaware and Delaware Citizens Association to improve education in the state. The Record Book documents the Association's activity from October 1926 - May 1927.
270 The record is in a scrapbook format and consists of correspondence, many from Etta J. Wilson, and newspaper or newsletter clippings. The book is divided into sections: Training for Leadership, Adult Night Schools, and Joint Educational Committee. Subjects include the county institutes, demonstration meetings, night school benefits, letters sent to members of the speakers' bureau, awakening public interest in building schools, school building legislation, publicity methods, news from local associations, local scrapbooks, standards set by the state P.T.A., annual convention, National Colored Congress, and Service Citizens of Delaware.

At the beginning of the book is a map of Delaware with locations of white and colored parent-teacher associations and statistics on the number of associations and membership. Two photographs of classroom scenes are on the first page.
