261 Wharton was a Dover resident who became an All-American football player at the University of Pennsylvania, 1895-1896. The photographs and ephemera relate to his football playing days and later reunions. He became a doctor, served in the Delaware State Senate, 1915-1916, became part of the University of Delaware faculty as a professor of physical education, and ran for governor in 1928.
270 The photographs include large Penn football team portraits, 1894 and 1895, a portrait of Wharton in his football uniform, 1896, and two team reunion photos, no date. Also included is an award of merit from the University of Pennsylvania Varsity Club which lists Wharton's accomplishments, 1946, and a name tag from the Pennsylvania - Princeton Football Dinner, 1935.
