entries for apples stored at Wyoming Cold Storage and Dover Cold Storage
describing the number, types, and grade. Starting in 1937, there are
pages recording the sale of asparagus. These entries note the date,
number of bunches, prices, and totals. A few entries for plums,
peaches, tomatoes, lima beans, and cucumbers are also present.
