documents compiled by Jean and Howard Row, reflecting their interest in
historic Dover and Delaware. They were the driving force behind Dover
Heritage Trail, which provided tours of the colonial and Victorian
sections of Dover. Dr. Howard Row was an administrator with the
Department of Public Instruction and served as a member of the Delaware
Heritage Commission.
270 Major subjects found here include architecture, 1976 and 1987
bicentennials, blacks, boundaries, Annie Jump Cannon, the state charter,
constitution, Lord de La Warr, Dover, Fort Delaware, governors, Dover
Green, James H. Groves School, Legislative Hall, maps, people, Caesar
Rodney, Thomas Rodney, Townsend Building construction and dedication,
Wilmington, Woodburn, and various houses and buildings in Dover. One
entire box contains files on the state charter, state boundaries, and
Sarah Wistar Miller. Three boxes contain material prepared for Dover
Heritage Trail tour guides. This background material was used for tours
of the Old Dover Historic District, the Walking Tours of Victorian
Dover, and for school groups. Another box contains videos related to the
Constitution and "Celebrate the 1st State". One oversize folder
contains reproductions of documents created as part of the
constitutional bicentennial celebration.
