 in 1783 and was located north of Milford.  
 270 The records include books that contain the 1783 original constitution of  
 the church, member records, and minute books. The member records  
 include baptisms and deaths that show name and date of event. Sometimes  
 the time of death was noted as well. These records specify if a member  
 was suspended, dismissed, excommunicated, moved or returned . The  
 minutes discuss individuals examined for baptism, suspensions and  
 excommunication; the incorporation of the church, appointment of  
 officers and trustees and how much time individuals will donate to the  
 church. A hymn "Rosa Lee the praria flower" is written here in its  
 entirety. There is correspondence from Mrs. P. E. LaMunya to  
 individuals concerning genealogical information contained in the church  
 records. A copy of the 1797 deed for the church property along with a  
 plot of Frances Conwell's house are also here. The trustees for the  
 Church at the time of land purchase were Dr. George W. Marshall, Rev. J.  
 B. Savage, Peter Kind, Cornelius Dewees, and Vincent Beswicks.
