Letter from George Read to President of Congress

Wilmington Jany. 16, 1778

Sir,

I have been Applied to for Commissions by the Owners of divers small Armed vessels, now fitting out within the State on a design of Cruizing within the River and Bay of Delaware to intercept such of the Enemies Vessels as may fall withing their reach or person; therefore I must Request the favous of you to inclose me by the bearer Capt. Issac Lewis, Twenty blank Commissions for private Vessels of War, and as may blank Bonds to Executed by the parties fitting out such Vessels,-agreeable to the Reselutions of Congress of the 3rd of April 1776.

No such blanks have been sent heretofore to this State to my knowledge, but is so, they were taken with our President by the Enemy.

The present Season is very favourable to the scheme of fitting out these Armed Vessel, the Enemies Ships of War having retired to distant Harbeurs and their trading Vessels are dropping in here singly and become easy Captures, a few instances of this last have already happened, and I have this further Expectation, that by this means we shall be enabled more effectually to prevent the Enemy from receiving Supplies along the shore of Delaware, which is so extensive, to wit, more than one hundred and twenty miles including our Sea board, that it is almost impracticable to guard the whoe by land forces. I shall estemm it as a favour in you to dispatch the Messenger in this business with all the Expedition in your power as there is certain intelligence that a number of small Vessels are coming round from New York with Merchandize and provisions, and I have the honour to be your most Obedt. Servt.
