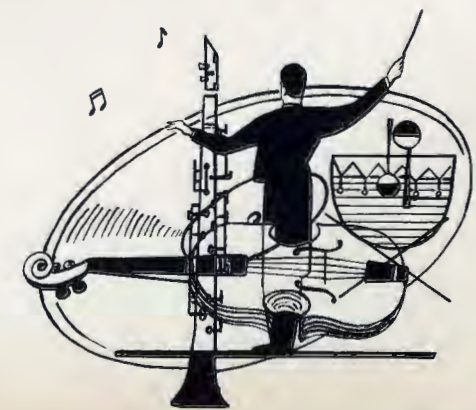

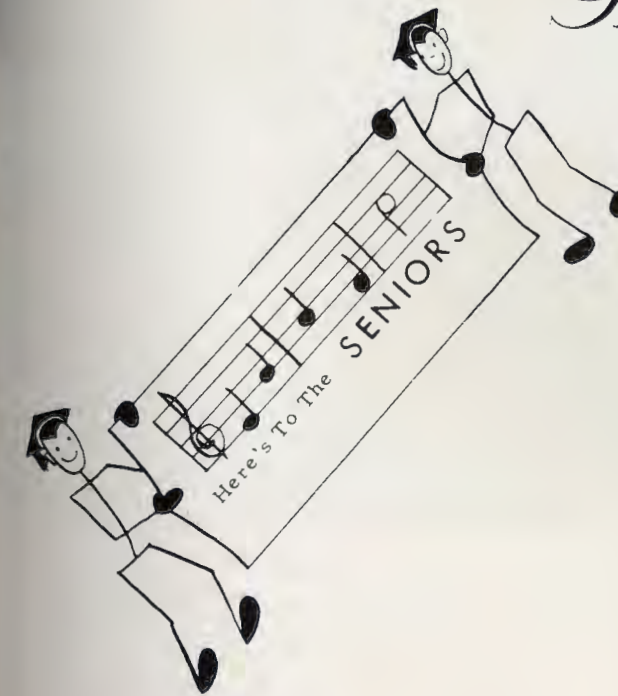

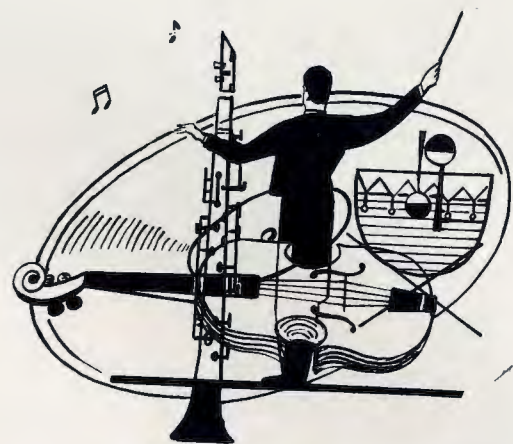

We did not get enough of this playing as CR lost to Smyrna in a fast action game. Chris Arndt goes up for points in this action.

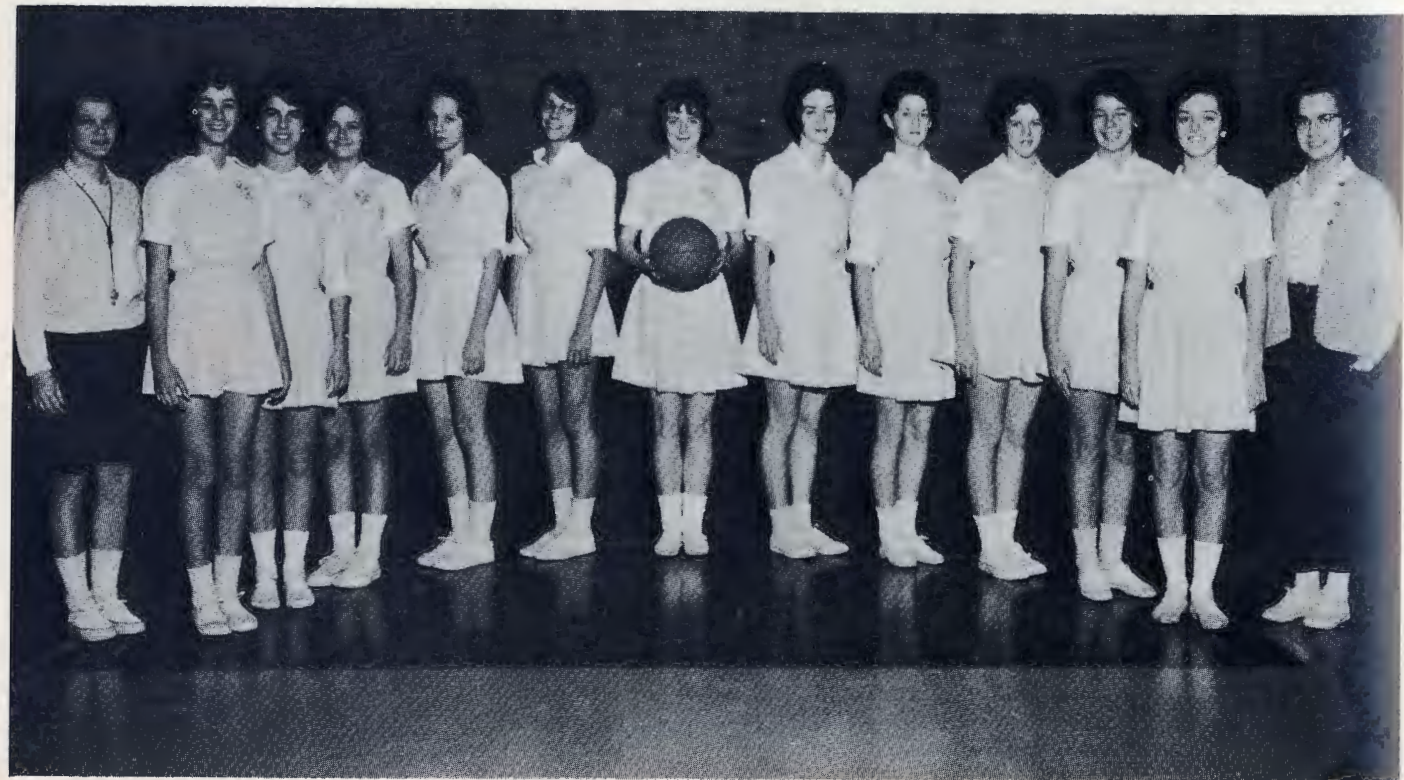
