Caesar Rodney

CAESAR RODNEY WAS BORN ON OCTOBER 27, 1728. FROM EARLY MANHOOD RODNEY WAS AN OUTSTANDING FIGURE IN THE OFFICIAL AND POLITICAL LIFE OF THE COLONIES. FROM 1766-1769 HE SERVED IN THE STATE ASSEMBLY, AND IN 1774 WAS ELECTED TO THE CONSTITUTIONAL CONGRESS.

IN 1776, BALLOTS ON THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE WERE PREPARED AND ON JULY 2, CAESAR, THEN IN ILL HEALTH, RODE FROM HIS FARM NEAR DOVER TO INDEPENDENCE HALL IN PHILADELPHIA, WHERE HE CAST HIS VOTE FOR INDEPENDENCE, BREAKING A DEADLOCK IN THE DELAWARE DELEGATION.

IN 1778, CAESAR RODNEY WAS MADE PRESIDENT OF DELAWARE. HE DIED IN 1784 OF CANCER AND WAS BURIED ON HIS FARM. IN 1887 HIS REMAINS WERE REMOVED AND BURIED IN THE EPISCOPAL BURYING GROUND OF CHRIST CHURCH, DOVER, WHERE A MONUMENT WAS ERECTED IN HIS HONOR.

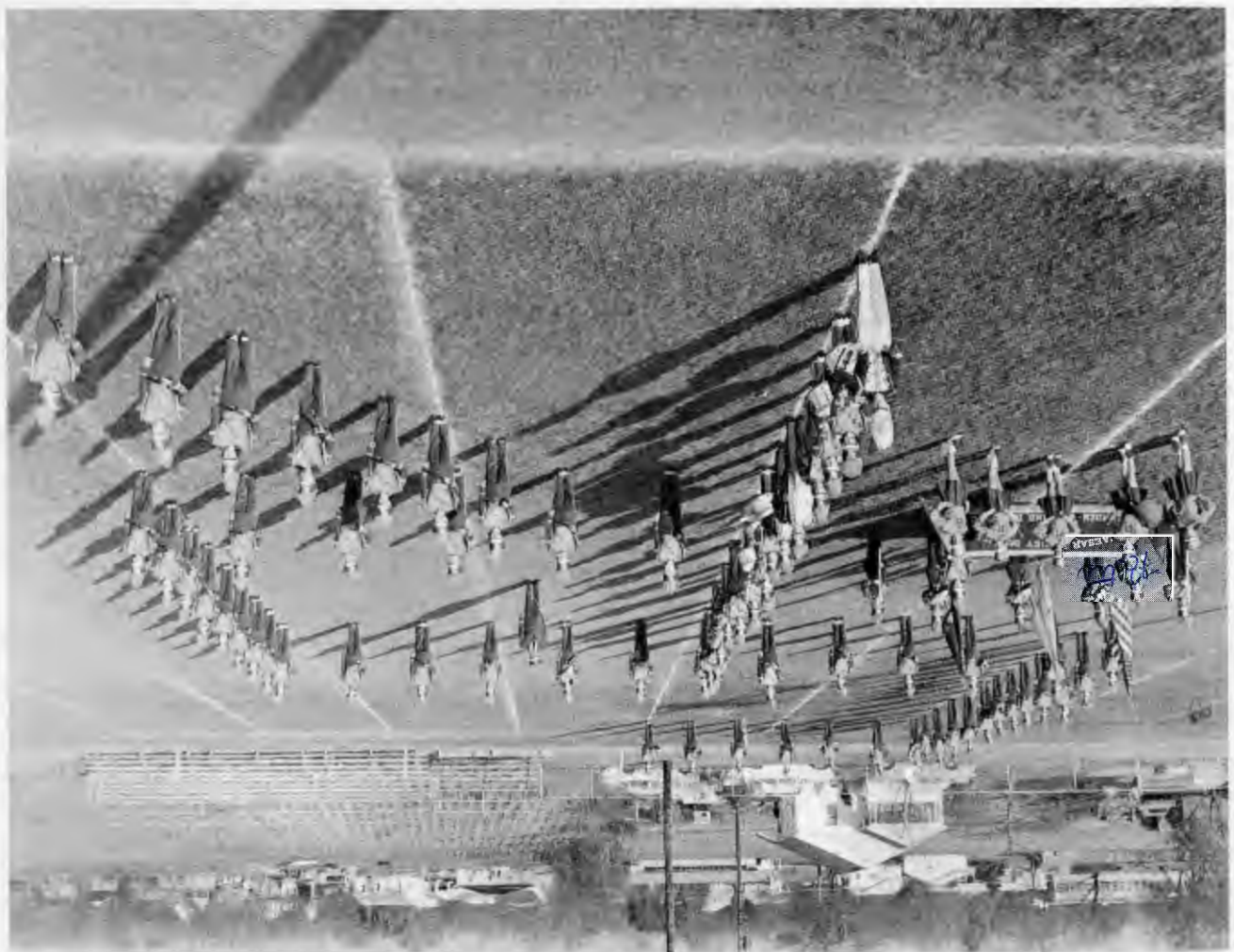

Forever encouraging, Mr. E. is always quick to congratulate on a performance whether it was truly good or not.

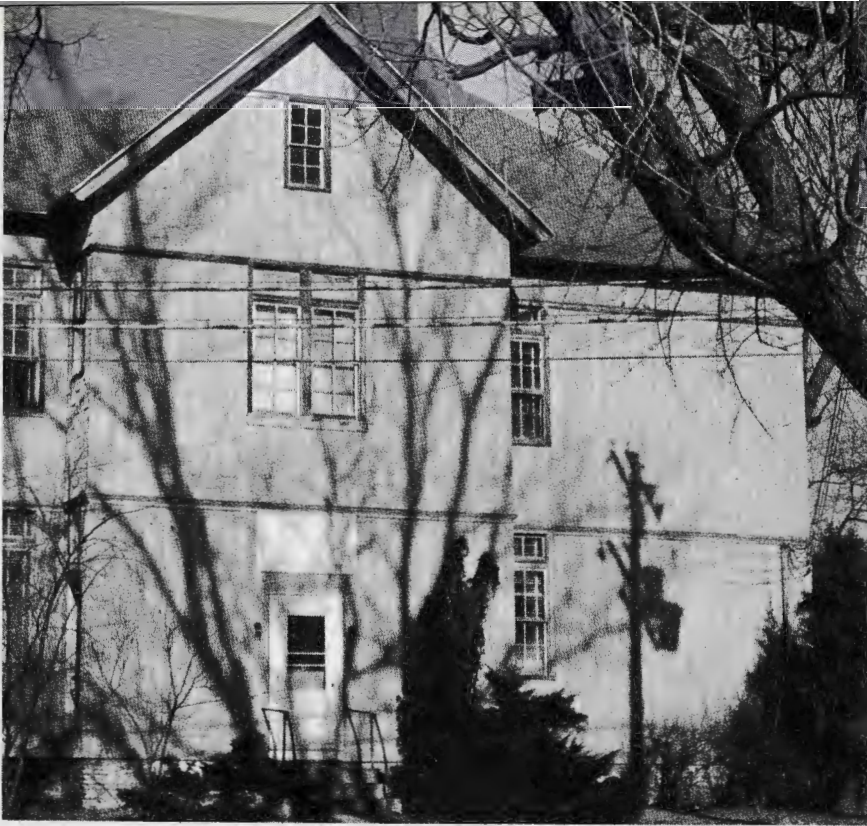

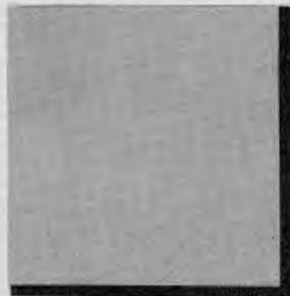
To The Graduating Class of 1967,

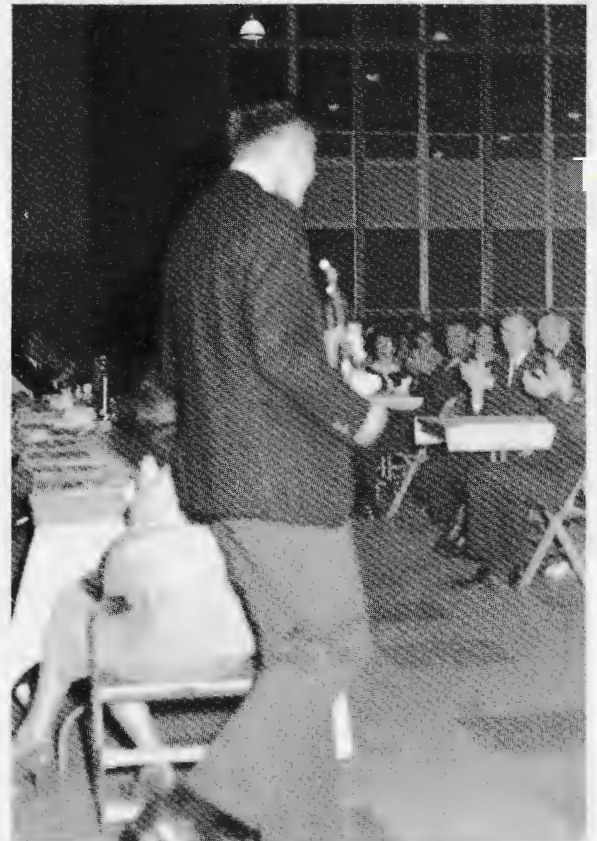

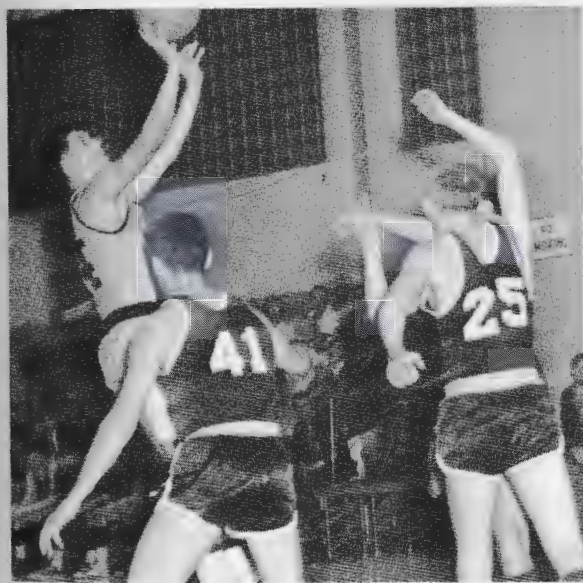

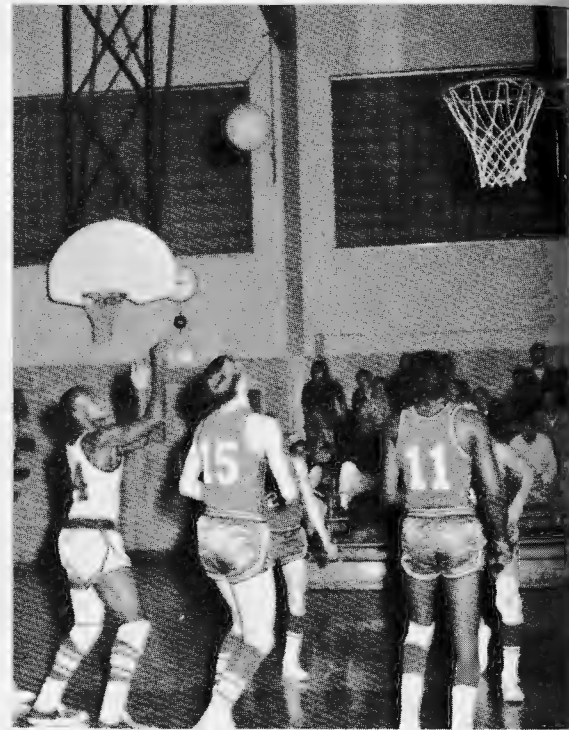

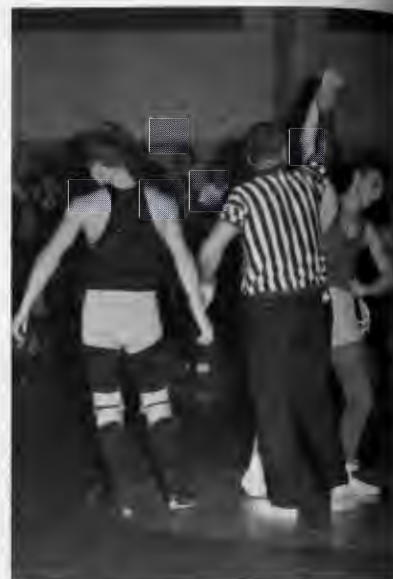
