

An Act in relation to Trustees of the Poor for South Murderkill, North Murderkill and Trenton Hundreds in Kent County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Delaware in General Assembly met:

Section 1. That the Trustees of the Poor hereafter to be appointed by the Levy Court for South Murderkill, North Murderkill and Trenton Hundreds respectively shall hold their office for the term of three years from the date of their appointment but vacancies shall be filled only for the residue of a term by the commissioners of the Levy Court of the hundred where the vacancy happens. Any thing contained in any law heretofore passed to the contrary notwithstanding Provided however that the first appointment under this act for South Murderkill Hundred shall be for but two years the first appointment for North Murderkill Hundred shall be for but one year and the first appointment for Trenton Hundred shall be for but two years.
