Sealed with our seals. —

Dated the *Eighteenth* day of January in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-three. —

W H E R E A S the said Henry C. Conrad has been duly elected and appointed Treasurer of the "Trustees of Delaware College for Colored Students", otherwise called "Trustees for the State College for Colored Students", under an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Delaware, entitled "An Act to establish and maintain a College for the Education of Colored Students in Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts" passed at Dover May 15th 1891. —
