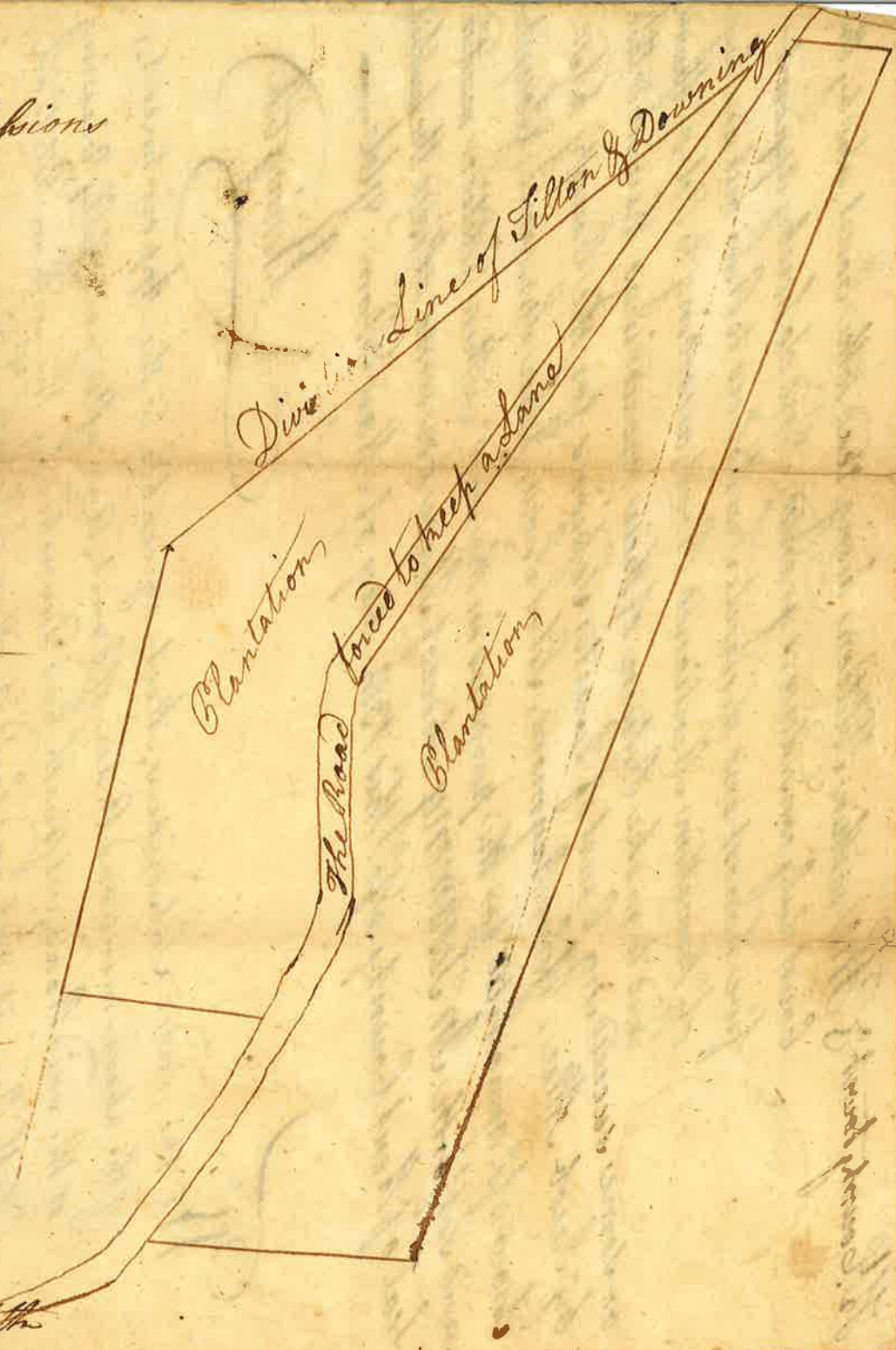


To the Worshipfull the Justices of the Court of Quarter sessions

 it now hath, to All the Inhabittance Whome it
 may concern — Your Petitioner Most
 Humbly Prays this Worshipfull Court to Appoint
 five Free holders to Lay out said Road along the
 Dividing Line agreeable to Act of Assembly in such case
 made & Provided and your Petitioner As in Duty
 Bound will ever Pray

The Petition of sundry of the Inhabitants of Duckport
hundred most humbly sheweth

Whereas it appears in the prothonotaries Office of the County
afo: there has been a Road laid out from Whitshall Lane
=ing to Duckport town, but whose Sentiments by
whome the o: Road was laid paying no regard either to
Convenience or Distance (as p: their Return) makes it very
uncertain at this Day where the o: Road was laid by
reason of its being often turned and still subject to be
turned by every Discontented Person thereon, which
proves much to the Disadvantage of your Petitioners
Therefore your Petitioners humbly pray your Worshipps
to nominate and appoint five freeholders, for the
relaying out the o: Road from Whitshall Landing to
Duckport town according to Law: and your Petitioners
as in Duty bound shall pray ~ Aug: 10. 1767 ~
