DELAWARE BANK BUILDING

THE FIRST BANK IN DELAWARE, ORGANIZED 1795 AND ^{originally} LOCATED FIRST AT NORTHWEST CORNER OF FOURTH AND MARKET STREETS, ERECTED THIS BUILDING AT SIXTH AND MARKET STREETS 1816, ~~AND~~ USED CONTINUOUSLY UNTIL 1931 ^{when} REMOVED TO PRESENT SITE AND DEDICATED AS THE HOME OF THE DELAWARE ACADEMY OF MEDICINE-1932.

SITE OF KING GEORGE TAVERN

1724-1863, ~~A TAVERN OCCUPIED THIS SITE. BEFORE THE REVOLUTION~~ ^{From 1724}

~~this IT WAS~~ KNOWN AS KING GEORGE TAVERN BECAUSE, ON ITS SIGN WAS PAINTED A PORTRAIT OF GEORGE III. AFTER THE REVOLUTION A PORTRAIT OF GEORGE WASHINGTON SUPPLANTED THE KING'S. FOR MANY YEARS THE OLD HOSTELRY WAS ^{meeting place} HEADQUARTERS FOR POLITICAL ^{Rallies} PARTIES AND ~~WAS~~ USED FOR GUBERNATORIAL RECEPTIONS. [TRADITION SAYS THAT CAESAR RODNEY RODE DIRECTLY FROM THIS TAVERN TO PHILADELPHIA TO VOTE FOR INDEPENDENCE.]

WOODBURN ^{on Kings Highway}

BUILT IN 1740 BY CHARLES HILLYARD, WHO MARRIED MARY, DAUGHTER OF WILLIAM KILLEN, FIRST CHANCELLOR OF DELAWARE. MEETING PLACE OF COMMITTEE OF SAFETY DURING REVOLUTION. HERE LADIES OF DOVER PREPARED SUPPLIES FOR THE CONTINENTAL SOLDIERS. ACCORDING TO TRADITION HERE CULMINATED PATTY CANNON'S FAMOUS RAID ON DOVER, AS VIVIDLY PORTRAYED IN "THE ENTAILED HAT", ~~AN HISTORICAL NOVEL OF EARLY LIFE ON THE DELMARVA~~ ^{Peninsula} PENINSULA. ^{by a Townsend}
