

an act appropriating the sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars for the payment of certain expenses incurred in building the state administration and Library Building, and altering the State House.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Delaware in General assembly met:-

Section 1. That the sum of Twelve Thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Treasury of this State for the purpose of paying certain extra expenses incurred in completing the state administration and Library Building and in altering and restoring the State House, such sum to be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, upon warrant or warrants drawn by the proper officers of the Commission named under the provisions of Chapter 3, Volume 25, Laws of Delaware, entitled "an act providing for the erection and equipment of a fire proof state administration and Library Building at Dover, and for the alterations to the State House",

such warrant or warrants to be approved by the State Auditor.
